



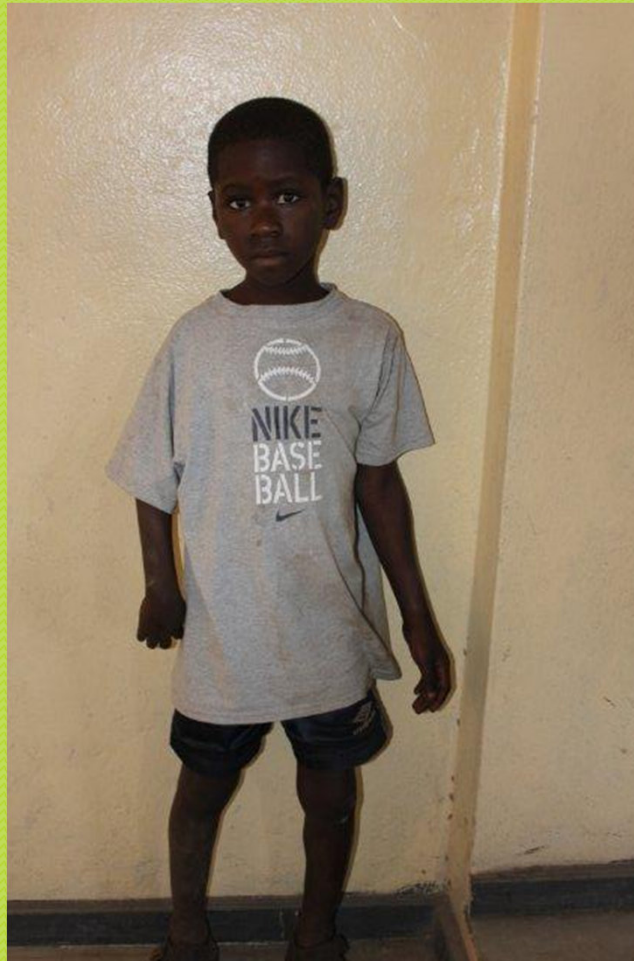

## Konah Yarwala, 9yrs

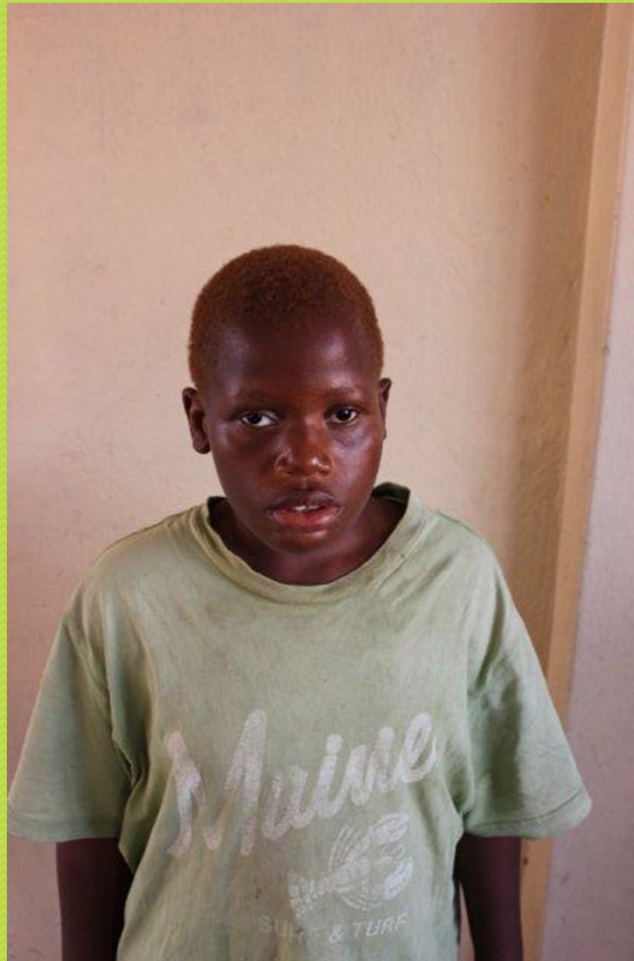
People in the community do not like me to go around them. That is very bad. My family members are not proud of me, only my grandmother. God come first, I want to talk and walk good.

## Ruth Nimene, 26yrs

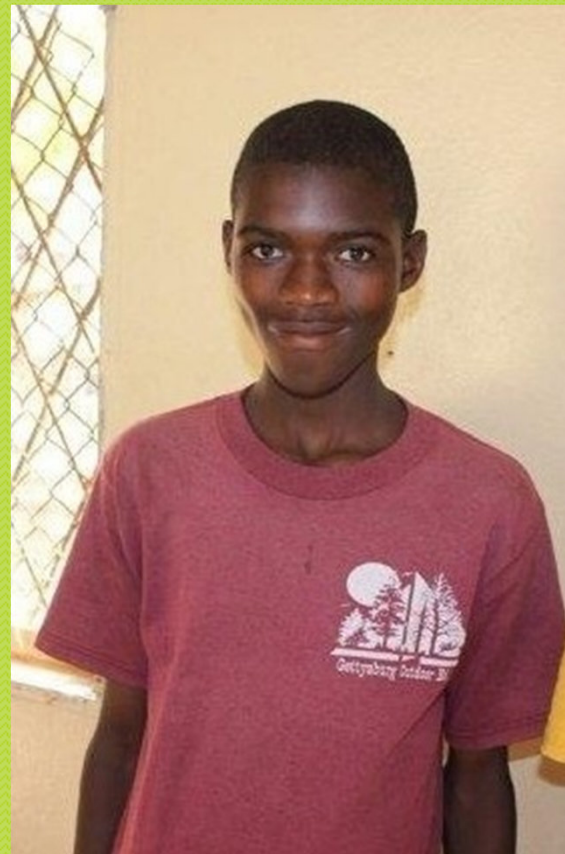
Some of my friends like me

## Comfort Davis, 34yrs

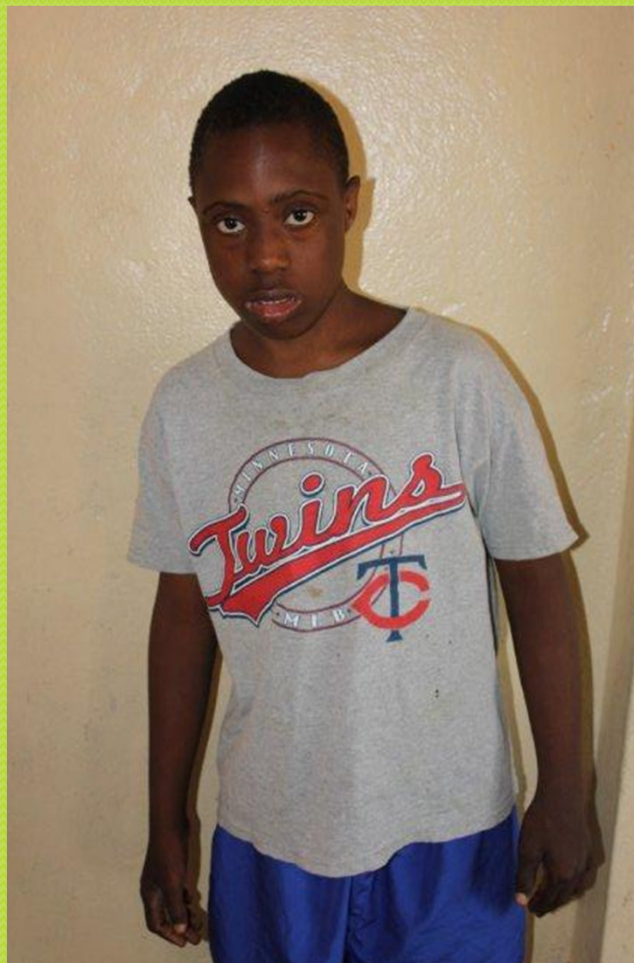
People in the community

## Bill Hney, 14yrs

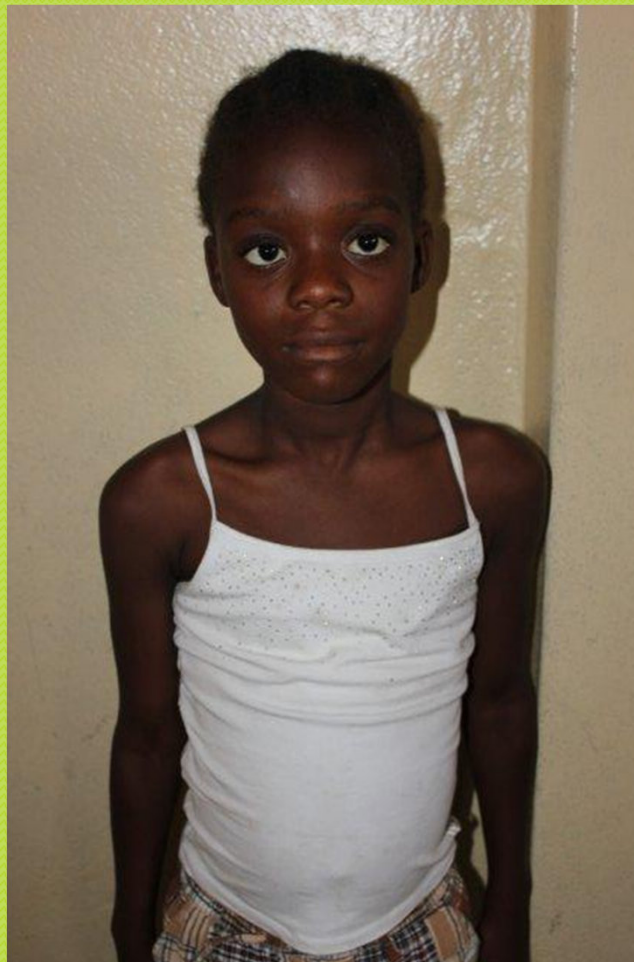
People in the community feel funny about me. My family is proud of me. I want to go to Big Ma's Care Place. I want to be like a preacher like Martin Luther King.
